



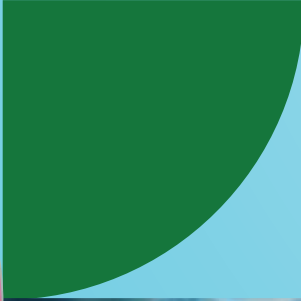
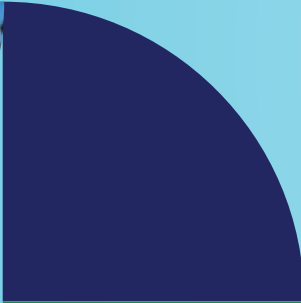

# Chennai, India & The ISCC-2026

*The International Sericultural Commission (ISC) take great pleasure in inviting you to the prestigious, XXVII Congress of the International Sericultural Commission (ISCC-2026) on Sericulture and Silk Industry scheduled to be held at Chennai, the automobile manufacturing and industrial city of India, from 23<sup>d</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2026.*





The ISC Congress, which is a triennial event, is the only international forum committed exclusively for the sericulture and silk sector that provides access to progress made in sericulture science and technology, current knowledge of the field, and the prevailing global business environment for silk.

Presentation of a large number of scientific papers, apart from several poster presentations covering the entire range of sericulture and silk production activities during the ISCC-2026, is expected to lead up to the formation and dissemination of current and new scientific and adaptive knowledge in the field of sericulture and silk, including honing up the base-line skills as well as core competencies of the participants.

A global assembly of this standing also envisages generating usable trade information, and promoting mercantile and economic relations among the silk producing countries.

In effect, the proceedings of the ISCC-2026 would bring together in a single, free, open, equitable access-resource, the collective knowledge and erudition of the international sericulture and silk community, displayed in the presence of an insightful global audience, which can be usefully translated into strategic tools for the advancement of sericulture and silk sectors in respective countries.

# The Theme

# Silk for a sustainable future

Silk is a natural, biodegradable fiber with high potential for sustainability. Over the years, silk industry inculcated many intricate production processes starting from food plant cultivation to the making of final products with the main objectives of enhancing the productivity and quality. The recent Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) studies on silk indicate major environmental hot spots in many of the production processes. This, rather consider an alarming outcome, points to the immediate global attention to urgently initiate research activities and policy actions for evolving technologies and techniques to reorient the production processes of silk for a sustainable future.

Keeping in view of the above facts, ISC has decided to adopt the theme of 27<sup>th</sup> ISCC-2026 as "Silk for a sustainable future". The participants may therefore give priority for submitting innovative and strategic inputs concerning their sectoral areas as abstract papers for in-depth deliberations in the ISCC-2026.

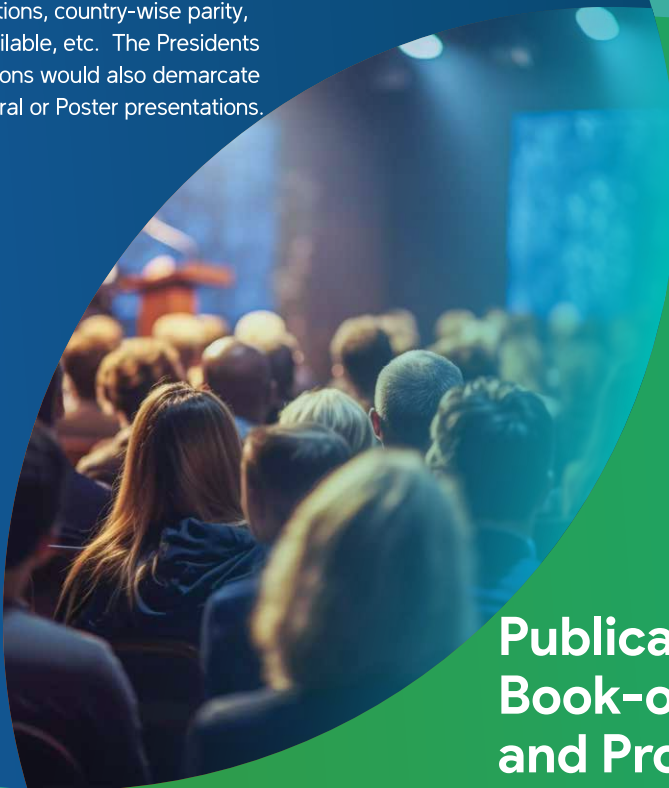

**Currency and Banking:** Foreign currency exchange service is available at the Chennai International Airport and the hotels.
